LOOKING FOR PARTNERS KA2 “STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP”

The project meets the mission of the ITALIAN NATIONAL MICROCREDIT AGENCY on promoting microfinance, which is to pursue poverty eradication and combat social exclusion.

The “Strategic Partnership” will analyze the situation that migrants face when starting a business. One of the obstacle that migrants face is the lack of professional workers with transferable skills. Another one is the inappropriate technical competencies they have on management and business. On the other side the economical problem will be approached through the promotion of microfinance loan.

The partners are coming from different context (NGOs working on migrants issue, Microfinance institutions and Sme) to facilitate the exchange of good practices and expertise. Each partner will bring expertise from its own projects and knowledge from situation in its own country. Best practices will be used to create a training week where 4 participants from each partner will train each other according to mentioned best practices. Later on, trainers will arrange an online course for migrants based also on best practices. In the meantime, an online platform will collect and spread best practices as well.

Each partner will work on a specific topic to retrieve best practices, according to its own expertise.
