



Program: EuropeAid Cooperation - IPA Programme

Deadlines: June 29th, 2012

Description: The program offers to the civil society organizations grants for individual projects. The program is designed to help them playing a strategic role in the development of Bosnia and Herzegovina. The call concerns the process of accession to the European Union.

Activities: this call aims at:

- a) stimulating and strengthening networks of civil society organizations, their cooperation and exchange of information and experiences so that they become a stronger partner government (Lots 1 -9),
- b) supporting civil society organizations in the fight against corruption, justice and security (lot 10-11),
- c) supporting CSOs to become involved in environmental best governmental partners to develop state policies as a solution to environmental problems (lot 12).

This call is carried out through 12 Lots :

Lot 1: Social Inclusion

Lot 2: Youth

Lot 3: Environment

Lot 4: Entrepreneurship

Lot 5: Education

Lot 6: Culture

Lot 7: Rural development and fight against unemployment

Lot 8: Health

Lot 9: Media

Lot 10: Anti-corruption

Lot 11: Justice and Home Affairs

Lot 12: Environment and Climate Change

Beneficiaries:

In order to be eligible for a grant, applicants must:

- be legal persons and non-profit;
- be non-governmental organizations;
- be established in an EU Member State or in a beneficiary country of the Regulation (EC) N ° 1085/2006 of 17 July 2006 establishing the Instrument for Pre-Accession Assistance - IPA (Croatia, Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Turkey, Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina,

Montenegro, Serbia, Kosovo under UNSCR 1244), or in a beneficiary country of the European Neighbourhood and Partnership Instrument (Algeria, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Belarus, Egypt, Georgia, Israel, Jordan, Lebanon, Libya, Moldova, Morocco, Palestinian Authority, the West Bank and Gaza Strip, Russian Federation, Syria, Tunisia and Ukraine), or in one of the Member States of the European Economic Area (Iceland, Lichtenstein and Norway;

- be directly responsible for preparing and managing the action, not acting as an intermediary

Amount available:

The overall indicative amount made available under this call amounts to EUR 3 million (for lots 1-11) and 0, 5 million euros for Lot 12.

How to participate:

The cofound varies between 50 and 90% of eligible costs.

Duration of activity (for lots 1-9 and 12): the expected duration of action cannot be less than 18 months and exceed 24 months. Time for Lots 10-11: the expected duration of action can not be less than 12 months nor exceed 24 months.
