The main aims of the research launched by EuroMed Platform are:

- understanding the role that young people have in interreligious and cultural dialogue in the Mediterranean region;
- identifying the tools that could help removing the barriers to interreligious and intercultural dialogue;
- identifying shared values and how young people could try to optimize these common values to create better cooperation in the region;
- giving example on how young people overcome prejudice and xenophobia through activities (what can we learn? Ideas for future projects?);
- finding out the positive outcomes. How does this dialogue lead to peace and stability in the region?
- Giving references to tools developed for such purposes.

The research should be available for being published by the end of October 2012.
